For that many years ago at the pre-Thanksgiving season Southern California's only full-time Christian radio station, owned and operated by Maple Chapel, Glendale, took to the air, introducing via this medium a format of spiritual broadcasts with sacred music, dramas, children's stories, Bible stories, chats with the pastor, and a variety of Christian organizations' programs.

Blanketing the Southland now 18 hours daily, starting at 6 a.m., this FM station, claims the ears of the "Cadillac" audience of radio with its topnotch gospel programming airing the artistry of Lorin Whitney, Tony Fon-

tane, Lee Childs, Haven of Rest, Back to the Bible, Orient Crusades, to name but a few of the many high quality programs.

A result of faith, 100,000 - watt KHOF-fm also highlights prominent Christian leaders on its daily broadcasts which are under the supervision of General Manager Roland C. Livingston, former motion-picture actor-executive and business leader, who found Christ in Los Angeles in 1945 through the testimony of a 17-year-old boy. Ordained later to the ministry, Mr. Livingston was active in Youth for Christ in cities of Odaho and Washington prior to affiliating in the spring of this year with KHOF-fm. He was also at one time on the national board of Gideons.

BOB SKEANS — engineer and announcer, attended RCA School of Electronics, Glendale College and Pomona California Polytechnic.



ACROSS PASTOR'S DESK

Wheels of work, oiled by prayer of pastor and people of Maple Chapel, turned constantly for more than three years in bringing to fruition on November 13, 1956, the voice of KHOFfm, the original vision of the Rev. Raymond Schoch, pastor of the Glendale Church.

Native of Pasadena, Calif., Rev. Schoch received his pastorial training at Southern California Bible College. Active in the ministry since 1947, he is responsible for not only establishing the nearly 200-member church, but Kahnack Christian Academy and Sa-Ha-Le Camp Grounds, also owned by the church corporation.

In 1953 he began to mount a series of obstacles that crossed his pathway for the ensuing three years in his effort to give to millions the gospel via the airlanes. To HERALD the message of FAITH to hungry multitudes was the purpose behind this avenue of outreach.

It was a vision of God's making, not of man's design that ultimately brought property, permits, people and plans into unison and KHOF wended its way into home, office, hospital and automobile radios of countless thousands throughout the Southland.

God sustained the faith of pastor and people "until that day" in November, 1956, when the button was pushed and KHOF sounded forth with a massed choir singing . . . "ALL HAIL THE POWER OF JESUS" NAME!"




